24-25 International Student Application Process

Before an I-20 can be processed we must receive the following:

- Last two years of report cards and official transcripts evaluated by SpanTran – use this link for a discount <https://bit.ly/mcs-spantran>
- Completed application
- Completed enrollment form
- Copy of passport and birth certificate
- The student’s foreign address and local address
- Most recent parent or legal guardian financial bank statement showing adequate funds to pay for the student’s education and living expenses while attending Miami Christian School. A minimum of one year’s tuition, fees and living expenses is required.

Student’s **grades 1st – 12th** must take the admissions assessment test once they arrive at MCS to begin schooling. Your student will be placed in the MCS ESOL program at an additional cost until the student passes the ESOL test. If they pass the ESOL test the first week they are in school, no ESOL charges will apply. Following the admissions assessment an appointment will be made for an interview with the student, the parents and the Principal. Upon acceptance to MCS a tuition management account must be created with BBTM.
